Now Accepting Teams for the 2015 MSYSA Spring State Cup & Jr. State Cup

Plymouth, Michigan (October 16, 2014) – The Michigan State Youth Soccer Association will host more than 3,000+ players from 200+ teams as they compete in the US Youth Soccer MSYSA State Cup, which will be played in the Spring of 2015. This will be the first of three legs in the US Youth Soccer National Championship Series. This spring season, MSYSA will host the following age groups: Under 13 Boys and Girls, Under 14 Boys through Under 18 Boys and Under 19 Boys and Girls. Additionally, MSYSA will host the 2015 Jr. State Cup this spring for teams in the U10 through U12 age groups.

The US Youth Soccer Association MSYSA State Cup Champions will qualify to compete for a regional title in the US Youth Soccer Midwest Regional Championships hosted in Fox Cities, Wisconsin on June 20-24, 2015. Those who are crowned champions at the US Youth Soccer Regional Championships in the Under 13 through Under 19 brackets earn a place to compete in the 2015 US Youth Soccer National Championships to be played on July 21-26, 2015 in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

2014 was an exciting and successful year for Michigan teams with the U13 Waza Boys crowned Champions and the U13 Michigan Hawks Girls crowned Finalists! MSYSA invites you and your team to participate in the 2015 MSYSA Spring State Cup Tournament.

The MSYSA State Cup Tournament is intended to provide teams a high level of competition for teams in the Under 13 through Under 19 age groups. If you or other teams you may be aware of, are interested in participating in the tournament, please make certain you register your team(s) before February 2, 2015 (December 15, 2014 for teams in the Under 19 age group). The cost per team to register if \$455 (Under 19 teams: \$455 + \$3,000 bond). The MSYSA State Cup is for current MSYSA league affiliated teams and MSYSA League affiliated members only. Preliminary matches will commence on March 14, 2015 and end on May 3, 2015. The MSYSA State Cup & Jr. State Cup Round of 16 and Quarterfinals will take place on May 16-17, 2015. The MSYSA State Cup & Jr. State Cup Semifinals & Finals are scheduled to take place on May 30-May 31, 2015. Additionally, the cost to register for the MSYSA Jr. State Cup is \$400 for teams in the Under-10 age group and \$445 for teams in the Under-11 and Under-12 age groups. The deadline to apply for the MSYSA Jr. State Cup is February 2, 2015 at 4:30pm.
