Dear MSYSA League Presidents & Delegates:

As a member of US Soccer (and US Youth Soccer), MSYSA is required to have and reference a specific prohibited conduct policy. On April 23, 2018, the MSYSA Board of Directors adopted US Youth Soccer's <a href="Code of Conduct Policy">Code of Conduct Policy</a>, effective immediately, and made the appropriate reference in <a href="MSYSA Rule 2.8">MSYSA Rule 2.8</a>.

The Code of Conduct Policy is intended to aid in preventing the abuse of minors or amateur athletes. The policy outlines prohibited substance(s) use, prohibited activities, prohibited physical contact with and/or between athletes, bullying, harassment, hazing, and it also requires individuals to report any violations or suspected violations of the policy. Representatives, members, and participants must respect and comply with this policy.
